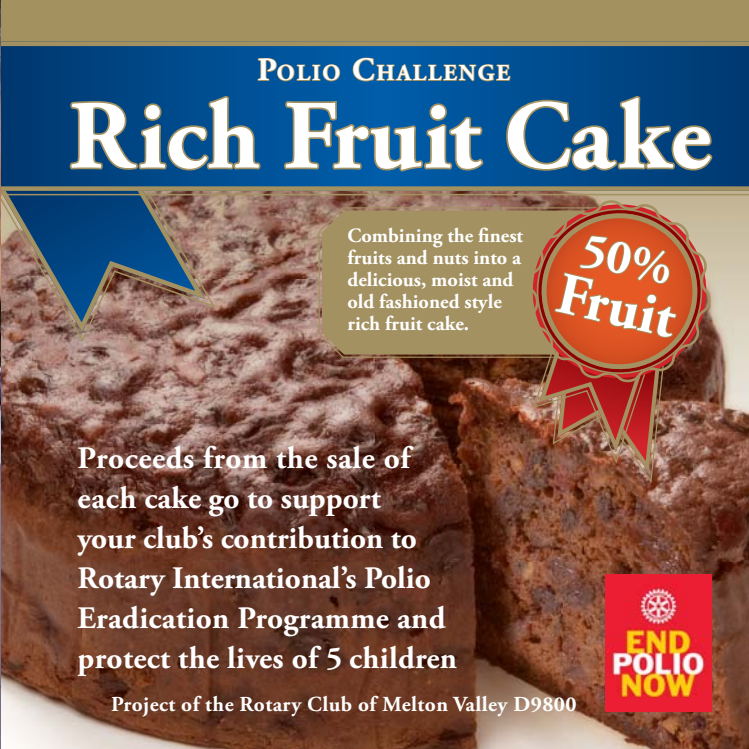

History of Rotary's Program of Polio Eradication

Since 1985, ending polio has been Rotary's top philanthropic goal. Since then, polio cases have been slashed by 99 percent worldwide. While most of the world is polio-free, this vaccine-preventable disease still threatens children in parts of Africa and South Asia.

Since November 26th, 2007 the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation have given The Rotary Foundation a grant of US\$355 million for Rotary's Polio Plus Program in which Rotary's challenge over the next 3 years is to raise US\$200 Million.

Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge is a continuation of Rotary's longstanding commitment to protect every child from this devastating disease.
